Monument Regulations Enacted May, 2011

<u>Double Monument</u>: The combined height of the base and headstone cannot exceed 28 inches in height at the highest point. The base is not to exceed 14 inches in width and 68 inches in length. Polished stone bases are not allowed, but the top 2 inches of the base may be polished.

Single Monument: The combined height of the base and headstone cannot exceed 28 inches in height at the highest point. The base is not to exceed 14 inches in width and 34 inches in length. Polished stone bases are not allowed, but the top 2 inches of the base may be polished.

<u>Cremains</u> – There will be up to four cremains allowed on one regular grave space. Only one single monument (upright) allowed with four names on it or one upright with up to three flats stones or markers.

Before a monument can be installed, the monument company must have the monument order approved by a member of the Cemetery Board.

Any order received without detailed specifications (height, width and length of base and headstone, and if there is a rough or polished edge on the base) will not be approved. Once approved, the order will be forwarded to the Cemetery's contractor for foundation installation.

Any exceptions to the above must have prior approval of the Cemetery Board.

St. Joseph Cemetery Association and its employees are not responsible for any damage incurred to monuments when moving them, if necessary, for grave openings.
