Explanation of Time and Talent

- 1. **Sacristan**—prepares the church for the Eucharist celebration. The sacristan marks the readings for the weekend liturgy, counts out the number of hosts, pours the wine in the cruet and cups for consecration. The person also readies the priest's vestment and places the Intro and Intercessions into the appropriate binders. Training is needed.
- 2. **Lector**—proclaims God's Word. Training needed.
- 3. **Altar Server (Youth)**—server at Mass who assists the priest at the altar. Must be third grade or older. Training needed.
- 4. Altar Server (Adult)—server at Mass who assists the priest at the altar. Training needed.
- 5. **Eucharistic Minister** assists in distributing Holy Communion to the faithful. Training needed.
- 6. **Hospitality Minister**—meets, greets and assists their fellow Christians to feel welcome at worship. Training needed.
- 7. **Choir Member**—leads and supports the song of the assembly.
- 8. **Piano/Keyboard**—plays the piano with professionalism and expertise at liturgies.
- 9. **Welcoming Committee** visits new parishioners in their home parish, gives them a welcoming packet, explains what is in the welcoming packet, and answers any questions the new parishioner might have about that parish.
- 10. **Eucharistic Minister to the Homebound**—takes communion to those who are not able to worship with the community because of sickness, age, or physical impairment. Some training needed.
- 11. **Launder Altar Linens at Home**—wash the purificators, corporals, and altar cloths used at Mass and wash altar server robes when needed. Training needed.
- 12. **Eucharistic Adoration**—giving an hour of time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.
- 13. **Funeral Dinners** (Choose one or more of the following) The meal is prepared by a caterer.
 - a. Serving the meal and cleaning up afterwards
 - b. Bringing a salad or dessert
 - c. Calling people to work or to bring a salad or dessert
